## Summer Programs 2017

The Henry County Conservation Department will offer summer programs. Activities will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. All children who have not completed first grade must be accompanied by an adult, as do all children requiring one-on-one aids while in school. Some programs may be a bit advanced for younger children; see camp descriptions for details and age restrictions. Programs will be geared toward school-aged children. Preregistration is required and all fees are due at least two weeks prior to the start of the program. All programs will begin and end at the Oakland Mills Nature Center unless otherwise noted. Activities will be held rain or shine. Dress accordingly. Canoe consent forms are found on our website on Youth Programs page. Avoid wearing sandals or flip flops.

- June 13th 1-3:00 p.m. Jurassic County Park- focus on reptiles, including dinosaurs; live snake and turtle; all ages but will be geared toward younger children; limit 25; \$5.00 per child.
- June 14th 1-3:00 p.m. "In a Galaxy Far, Far Away...." Star Wars fan? Do stars fascinate you? Come learn about the night sky. What is a comet? What galaxy are we in? How does a light saber work? All ages but will be geared toward older children; limit 25; \$5.00 per child.
- June 15th 1-3:00 p.m. Zombie Apocalypse! How will you survive if it happens? What skills will you need? How do you build a shelter? All ages but will be geared toward older children; limit 25; \$5.00 per child.
- **June 19th 10-noon Finding Dory**-Last year was a quest for Nemo- now let's see if we can catch Dory! All ages but kids who have not completed 2nd grade must be accompanied by an adult; fishing poles/bait provided; limit 15; \$5.00 per child.
- June 21st 10-noon Magic in the Water- Pond study and unbelievable things in the water; bring rubber boots or shoes that can get wet/muddy; NO sandals or crocs; all ages; limit 25; \$5.00 per child.
- June 23rd 10-noon Secret Life of Owls- Want to know more about owls? How about other birds of prey? This program will feature live raptors; all ages; no limit to number of participants; FREE but must pre-register.
- June 27th 10:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. Smoke Signals part 1- throw atlatals, Native American make and take games (we will even play them), and outdoor cooking; must have completed **3<sup>rd</sup>** grade; lunch provided; limit 12; \$12.00 per child.
- June 28th 10:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. Smoke Signals part 2- archery, MORE Native American make and take games, and outdoor cooking; must have completed 3rd grade; lunch provided; limit 12; \$12.00 per child.
- June 29th 10:00 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. Smoke Signals part 3- canoeing, even MORE Native American skills, and outdoor cooking; lunch provided; must have completed 3rd grade; limit 12; \$12.00 per child; need canoe consent form signed by a parent.
